Drawing and Watercolor Supply List

Paper

1 Mixed media pad (98lb paper), 9" x 12" or similar size 2-4 sheets of Cold Pressed 140 lb. Arches paper 22" x 30"

<u>Watercolor Paints</u>: Get the best paint you can afford. Artist grade tube paints or pan paints are recommended. You may mix most colors from these basics:

Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Lemon Yellow, Burnt Sienna, Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Red, Burnt Umber, Yellow Ochre, Chinese White, Ivory Black

Ink: small bottle permanent black India ink

Watercolor Brushes

Round Brushes (#2, #6, #12 smooth hair)
I recommend Princeton Snap, Neptune and Black Velvet brushes
Flat Brush (1" flat brush)

Drawing Supplies

Drawing Pencils: 2B, 6B
Extra fine black sharpie marker
Soft vine charcoal or soft charcoal pencil
Ruler
Erasers - 1 magic rub white and 1 kneaded
Hand held pencil sharpener
1 Bamboo rib drawing tool or set

Other

- Water Container (a large plastic container)
- Watercolor Palette (one with a lid is recommended)
 Example: Mr. Pen- Airtight Watercolor Palette with Lid, 1 Pack, 18 Wells and 2 Mixing Areas
- Paper Towels
- Masking Tape or painter's tape
- Small spray bottle
- Optional: A board to hold your paper (The studio has extra boards you can borrow)
