Tube Colors Recommended: Watercolor Paints: Get the studio or artist grade. You may mix most colors from these basics:

Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red, Ultramarine Blue, Lemon Yellow, Cadmium Yellow, Burnt Umber, Chinese White, Ivory black

Optional Pan Sets: Pan watercolors are good for travel or quick sketches: Buy a good quality set of basic colors - Kuretake Gansai Tambi Watercolor Paint 12 Pan Sets, Prang, Faber Castell Creative Studio Half Pan Watercolor Sets

## Brushes

Watercolor Brushes
Round Brushes (Liner, \#2, \#6, \#12 natural or synthetic)
Flat Brush - $1 / 2 \prime$


## Other items

Water Container (a large plastic container)
Plastic palette with large areas for mixing paint
(alternative: large ceramic white plate)
Paper Towels
2 H drawing pencil
Sketch paper or pad
Ruler
Eraser-1 magic rub white or kneaded
Masking tape or painter's tape $-1 / 2$ " or wider
Spray bottle or mister

Masking fluid
Hair dryer
