Required

We will be working in 18g, 16g, and/or 14g SHEET. My demonstrations of the construction and soldering of multiple bracelet designs in cuff and bangle forms will be in any/all of these three gauges in either red brass, nickel or sterling silver. You may

- Purchase from the instructor at the start/during the workshop-
 - Red brass, copper, and nickel in 18g, 16g, and 14g sheet (14g not available in nickel) available in 6" x 6" and/or 1" increments x 6" and/or 1" increments x 12".
 - Instructor will have an assortment of pre-made bezel cups, heavy wall tubing, and stones available for purchase. In addition, red brass, nickel, and copper wire in both round and square will be available.

NOTE: Please email instructor if you plan on purchasing ALL sheet materials in workshop with metal preference(s), gauges and sizes you want.

And/Or

- Purchase from following resources
 - 6" x 6" and/or 6" x 12" and/or 1" increments x 6" or longer of either 18g, 16g and/or 14g red brass (aka. Nu-gold, Dix's gold, Jeweler's Brass), nickel, copper or sterling silver for one bracelet, OR
 - much of one or all of these three gauges in one or multiple metals.
