- Art Clay Silver 999 50g or PMC Fine Silver or One Fire Sterling
- Silver Clay Syringe Type
- Silver Clay Paste Type
- Main work surface - 1 plain large ceramic tile or something similar
- Assorted spacer bars or rolling frames
- Roller
- Badger Balm or Cool Slip
- Pergamano Needle Tool - this has a very fine needle for piercing
- Water brush or paint brush

- Small rubber tip tool
- Tissue blade or single edge razor blade
- Small diamond files
- 1 large emery board (not a metal file please)
- Fine pointed tipped tweezers
- Precision measuring calipers
- Ultra rule - This is ideal to achieve accuracy
- Mechanical pencil
- Snake roller
- Rubber block - This must be the square block type
- Jewelers saw frame with blades 8/0 size (bring spares)
- 3mm round file (exact size please)
- Sponge wipe-out tool (I will bring spares)
- Fireable faceted gemstone of your choice (6mm or 8mm) with corresponding size drill setting burr (no semi-precious or cabochons please)
- Pin vice hand drill
- Small packet of soft polymer clay
- Large pots of 2-part silicone moulding compound (Siligum is the recommended brand)
- Circle template
- Cling food wrap
- Wet wipes
- Kitchen paper towel
- Clay keeper pot
- Very shallow textures of your choice
- Sticky tape
- Water spritz bottle
- Pliers, cutters, snipe nose, flat nose
- Sanding grits
- Cord or chain to complete the piece (unless the student would prefer to add later when they return home)
