NOTE: Print your photos on inexpensive, ink jet paper or matte paper, Please, **NOT GLOSSY PHOTO PAPER OR LASER PRINT PAPER.** The wax absorbs into the porous ink jet paper much better than glossy, or laser paper

Tips

- Choose photos that have an easy recognizable focal point: 1 flower versus flower bush.
- Photos that are yellow/orange heavy or blue heavy soak wax up well.
- Dark photos, heavy black will get darker with wax.
