- Paint:
- Bring Red, Blue, Yellow minimum to the first class

- Brush:
- I like a size 10 or a size 12 round point. Princeton Heritage watercolor brushes are good quality and affordable

- 100% cotton paper in a block, pad or loose sheets. If it is cotton, it will be printed on the jacket. It is a must. Arches is quality paper and the brand that I use most.

- Paper can be taped to any rigid, non-porous material: plastic or glass cutting board, plexiglass sheet, plywood, drawing board, whiteboard, etc. Foam core will eventually warp, but it's an affordable option.
