



Supply List

Line and Wash House Portraits

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- Supplies will cost around \$30-\$50 depending on the quality and quantity of the materials.
- Paint:
 - Any red, Ultramarine blue, any yellow and burnt umber or black
 - [daniel smith 6-color set at dick Blick](#)
 - [cotman \(student grade\)](#)
- Brushes:
 - Size 6 round watercolor brushes with good point, and a size 1 rigger brush
 - [simply simmons \(student grade brush\)](#)
- Paper:
 - 140 lb cold press or hot press watercolor paper in a block, pad or loose sheets. Blocks do not need taping, but any other form of paper will need to be adhered to a surface with low-tack tape so that your paper doesn't wrinkle as you paint.
 - [canson cold press blocks](#)
 - [foam core boards \(5\)](#)
 - [artist tape](#)
 - Paper can be taped to any rigid, non-porous material: plastic or glass cutting board, plexiglass sheet, plywood, drawing board, whiteboard, etc. Foam core will eventually warp, but it's an affordable option.
- White gel pen
- Pigma micron pens or Uni pen (or other permanent pen other than sharpie) size .5
- Pencil, eraser, sharpener
- 2 small water containers
- Paper towels
