Paper

- One pad Strathmore Mixed Media Paper 400 Series 140 lb 18 x 24
 - Tape off 4 sheets with 1 inch tape
- 4 or 5 sheets of white tissue paper

Paint

- Acrylic Paint - 2 oz. tubes – suggested colors:
 - Cadmium Yellow Light
 - Yellow Oxide or Yellow Ochre
 - Raw Sienna
 - Mars Black
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Thalo Blue or Pthalo Blue - Green Shade
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Quinacridone or Quinacra Crimson
 - Naphthol Crimson
 - Thalo Green or Pthalo Green - Blue Shade
 - Dioxazine Purple
 - Hookers Green
 - Titanium White (a big tube)
- Liquid paint – any color - 2 or 3 bottles

Brushes, shapers, palette knives

- 2 or 3 credit cards
- 2 or 3 chip brushes - 2 in. to 4 in.
- Pig bristle brushes – various sizes – ½ in. to 1½ in.
- Any color shapers to scratch back with
- Plastic fork and knife
- Any palette knives
- Liquitex paddle brushes if you have them
- Catalyst brushes if you have them - made by Princeton
- Any other brushes you love - I like a variety in size and kind

Mediums

- 1 pint matte medium
- 1 pint White Gesso

Drawing Supplies

- #2 pencil

- Alphacolor Char-Kole 1 stick
- White wax candle
- 5 or 6 Watersoluble Lyra or Caran D'ache crayons or pencils
- 5 or 6 Regular colored pencils or Art Stix
- Wax crayons
- 2 or 3 inks – any color. FW, Liquitex, and Bombay are good – one can be metallic
- Sharpie markers - bullet Point
- Paint markers – Liquitex, Krink, Montana
- Conte - black, brown or red
- White China marker
- 1 white oil pastel
- 2 or 3 colored cray-pas or oil pastels
- 2 ballpoint pens
- Any other drawing materials that you would like to bring

Other Supplies

- One disposable palette – 12 x 18
- 1 soft rubber brayer – 4 in.
- 1 foam roller - 3-4 in.
- 3 or 4 Glad cups for extra paint and inks
- Templates or stencils
- One large old beach towel (will get paint on it)
- Several old cloths for paint
- Three large bulldog clips
- Corrugated cardboard or bubble wrap
- 1 or 2 sponges to print with
