BRUSHES: Make sure that all your brushes are specifically for watercolor. Princeton Neptune, Princeton Snap! and Princeton Velvet Touch are all great brushes.

- One 1" flat brush
- One # 2 round brush
- One # 6 round brush
- One # 12 round brush

PAPER: Basic inexpensive watercolor paper, whatever size you want to use.

PAINTS: Please buy the best paint that you can afford- better quality paints make for better paintings. Artist grade paints are what to look for. I highly recommend getting the 12 or 18 color set by the company Holbein- they are amazing.
