

Painting Flowers with only the Palette Knife Workshop

I will be demonstrating and painting in acrylic. For a small fee (\$15) I will provide your supplies. You are welcome to do this workshop in oil.

Please bring the minimum supplies listed below as well as any other paints, brushes, etc. you typically use.

Paint - minimum colors include all primaries: 2 reds (cadmium red and alizarin crimson), 2 yellows (cadmium yellow and lemon yellow), 2-3 blues (your choice), black and white. Naples yellow, yellow ochre, purple, orange, magenta, sap green, burnt sienna and turquoise are good extras.

At least one Palette Knife – approx. 2"-3 bent trowel with rounded tip about \$6 at art supply stores - not plastic.

Bring two medium sized stretched canvases of your choice either rectangular and/or square - 12x12, 11x14, 16x20, 20x20, etc.

A palette – disposable wax paper palette pads work fine (about \$5 for a book of 50). A gallon size ziplock bag works well to transport used disposable palette.

A pen, pencil and sketch pad.

Favorite music.

Snacks and a Drink.

Paper towels.

Photo images of flowers - close up versus from a distance.
