- Pencils - Graphite pencils 2H, HB, 2B, 4B, & 6B (1 each)
- Ebony Pencil or dark graphite 8B pencil
- Charcoal Sticks & Pencils – soft and medium assortment
- Vine Charcoal - Medium
- Conte' Crayons - Black, white, sanguine, and bistre (brown)
- Blending Stumps - Small and medium sizes
- Value Grey Scale – Printed chart showing grey values from light to dark
- Erasers - White eraser (Factis, Magic Rub, or Staedtler) & grey kneaded eraser
- Spray Fixative – Workable Fixative (Blair, Grumbacher, Krylon, or Winsor- Newton brands)
- White Drawing Pad - Spiral bound 18"x 24" for in-class use,
- Sketchbook for personal use: 9"x 12" or 11"x 14"
- Colored Charcoal Paper (by the sheet) – 1 or 2 sheets of Canson or Strathmore paper in Medium Grey or Tan
- Masonite Clipboard – Large enough to hold your pad of paper (at least 18" or larger)
- India Ink with Dip Pen and Nibs – Bottle of Speedball, Bombay, or Higgin's Black India Ink and Speedball "Sketching" or "General Purpose" nib set
- Brushes – One or two decent nylon, watercolor brushes #2 and #4
