- Graphite Pencils - 2H, HB, 2B, 4B, 6B
- Ebony Pencil(s)
- Charcoal Pencils – (Black) Soft, Medium, & Hard plus White Charcoal Pencil
- Compressed Charcoal Sticks – Soft, Medium, & Hard
- Vine Charcoal – Soft or Medium 3 pack. Winsor Newton
- Conte' Crayons – Black, White, Sanguine (terra cotta), & Brown
- Conte' Pencils – Black, White, Sanguine (terra cotta) & Brown
- Paper Blending Stumps – rolled with points on both ends or on one end
- 18" x 24" White Drawing Pad – Any decent brand will do
- 18" x 24" Canson Mi-Tientes Charcoal/Pastel Papers
- Erasers – Kneaded & Thin Mechanical Eraser from Papermate or Sanford
- Set of Basic Color Assortment Chalk Pastels – (Sets of 24 - 48 preferred) Rembrandt , Nu-Pastel, Winsor Newton, Daler-Rowney, or Faber Castell
- Masonite Clipboard
- Workable Spray Fixative – Krylon, Grumbacher, Blair, or Winsor Newton
