## <u>Yarn</u>

To create a bag like the one pictured with the class listing, you will need the following yarn:

- Yarn Weight 4 any fiber will do, I prefer cotton for lined bags like this
  - 1 Skein Pink
  - 1 Skein Orange
  - 1 Skein Gold

<u>**OR**</u> you may choose your own color scheme of 3 different colors, 1 skein each. You can also do a single solid color and should only need 1 skein for this small bag. Be sure to choose a yarn weight of 4, do not mix weights! And avoid mixing fibers if at all possible. *DO NOT SHOP BY COLOR ALONE*.

#### Lining

- .25 yds each natural muslin & calico
- 6" zipper
- thread (match to calico)
- Optional tassel: 1 skein of 2 colors of embroidery floss, wooden beads, 3" cardboard
