- Foam core board to adhere pastel substrate
- Masking tape
- Uart (pastel mat, art spectrun, gatorboard sizes 11x14-16x20 minimum) or other sanded paper for pastel surface (one that accepts liquid eg: rubbing alcohol). No Canson Mi-Tienes paper.
- Pastels: Good assortment of at least 30-60 pastels of various values: light, medium and dark; various colors from hard pastels to soft pastels (nupastel hard; Rembrandt, Sennelier, Mount Vision etc.) Half sets are fine since they have a greater variety of colors.
- Gouache, watercolor & acrylic if you'd like to work -in multi-media for washes under the pastels.
- Rubbing alcohol, or Gamsol in a sealed bottle.
- Brushes: Small, medium and large inexpensive
- Any tools you would like to use: tortillions, sponges etc.
- Soft pencil or vine charcoal for sketching
- Sketchbook
- Kneaded eraser
- Paper towels

Helpful:

- Black & white value scale
- Color Wheel
- Clips to hold piece of artwork to easel
- Easels & Tables provided at the studio!
- Good variety of Landscape photos in color with a black and white version' of those photos you'd like to paint.
