GENERAL SUPPLIES:

- Board or foamcore to attach substrate: canvas, paper or matboard etc.
- Tape/clips to hold canvas
- small sketchbook
- Vine Charcoal
- Value scale
- Any tools you prefer to work with your chosen medium (rags, stumps, tortillion, palette kinives, brushes. (STRAIGHT RAZOR FOR OIL PASTE LISTS).
- Paper towels
- Tracing paper or Glassine at least the size of Canvas to cover
- OPTIONAL: MASK, APRON, FINGER COTS OR GLOVES, BABY WIPES

OIL PASTELISTS BRING (In addition to general supplies):

- Good variety of Oil Pastels: Prefer Holbein or Sennelier of various colors and values. Water soluble Oil Pastels permissible.
- Medium to move the oil pastels: Resin gel, Gamsol, turpenoid, baby oil, Gamblin solvent free gel medium, Gamblin Galkyd, Schmaltz Impasto gel or any medium that will move the oil pastel
- (walnut oil etc)
- Substrate AT LEAST 11X14": pastel paper, watercolor paper, pastel board, archival & acidfree matboard, Sennelier Oil Pastel Card, primed canvas (YOU MAY WANT TO BRING 2)

OIL PAINTERS BRING (In addition to general supplies):

- Good variety of oil colors including black & white
- Palette for mixing
- Variety of brushes/palette knives if you use and have
- Oil primed cotton, acrylic or linen canvas (2) at least 11x14'
- Optional: Oil Paper Canvas
- Medium of choice: Gamsol, walnut oil, etc.
- Rags, cloth
- Brush carrier & cleaner
- Container for cleaning brushes/cup for Medium

SOFT PASTELISTS BRING (In addition to general supplies):

- Good Variety of hard and soft pastels of various colors and values (Nu Pastels, Girault, Sennelier, Rembrandt, Mount Vision, Unison, Pan Pastels, Townsend, Schminke, Holbein, Terry Ludwig)
- Suggested Substrates MIDTONE:
- Unison Sanded 400 or 500, Pastel Board, Lux Archival Sanded Papers, Pastel Mat, Canson Mi-
- Tienes, Sennelier sanded surfaces, Ampersand PastelBord, Art Spectrum, Pastel Premier Sanded Paper sheets
- 90% Rubbing Alcohol for underwashes
- Various Tools if you have them: Stumps, sponges, tortillions, brushes
