Sculpting With Air-Dry Clay

- Pre-Class Assignment – I will send out a Power Point slide illustrating various styles of sculpture. If you are new to sculpture or air-dry clay, think about how you might want to use this material. Will your sculpture be more realistic or abstract? Will your surface be rough or smooth? Will you want to add color or texture to your sculpture after it dries?
- 16 oz Paper Clay (available at Michaels, Hobby Lobby and Amazon)
- Apoxie Sculpt (available on Amazon in .25lbs or 1lbs)
- Sculpting tools (I like stainless steel over plastic or wood, these are available on Amazon)
- Needle nose pliers
- 12, 14, or 16-gauge galvanized wire
- Gorilla Glue
- Masking Tape
- Xacto Knife
- Coping Saw
- Sandpaper (Medium Grit)
- Small cup for water

NOTE: I will bring extra of all these materials, but you will have to purchase your own Paper Clay. The class will go smoother if everyone has their own materials, but I am happy to share.

The \$35 material fee will go towards pre-purchased items we will use to build a turn table and the sculpture stand. If you don't need a turn table, please bring your own and let me know by Oct. 10.
