## Supply List

### Vintage Jewelry Art

Instructor: Starr Petronella

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**Feel free to reach out if you have any questions.**

For this class you may or may not have your own jewelry stash to work with and that's alright. I have been collecting and will have a large stash to play with, *for an additional fee*, for those who do not have their own.

**I have put together 3 different material fees for various options.**

- **OPTION A: \$30 MATERIAL FEE if you have your own jewelry to work with**
- **OPTION B: \$60 (\$30 MATERIAL FEE + \$30 IF YOU DO NOT HAVE ANY JEWELRY)**
- **OPTION C: \$30 MATERIAL FEE + can buy a few special pieces a la carte (like brooches)**

### **MATERIAL FEE:**

**DUE TO INSTRUCTOR DAY OF CLASS - VENMO OR CASH ACCEPTED**

### **MANDATORY MATERIAL Fee (\$30) includes provided material:**

- velvet fabric - black, navy or green (cross between hunter and emerald) may have more colors at time of class
- Spray glue for the velvet
- Fabric and jewelry adhesive
- Tools for cutting and removing backings
- Frames will be included, but please see note below (bring one if you have a certain style you like)
- Some additions to your jewelry stash to help complete your vision

### **Supply list:**

- **Bring 8x10 frame that you would like to put your artwork in**
  - I will have some, but they will be thrifted and of vintage vibe. Depending on what you like they may or may not be your style. Bring cardboard insert if it comes with one, do not remove.
- **Costume jewelry to bring-**
  - **IF YOU HAVE YOUR OWN JEWELRY:** Some basic jewelry will be provided

for use at time of class if you have your own and need some supplemental pieces.  
Brooches can be purchased for \$3 each. Venmo or cash payment is accepted.

- IF YOU DO NOT HAVE JEWELRY OR MAYBE JUST A FEW PIECES, \$30 will cover your jewelry (don't worry I will have tons to work with)
- Broken or random pieces
- Necklace or bracelet chains - any kind (they make good borders or outlines)
- Beads - if threaded, leave on. May be easier to apply if securing multiple pieces
- Earrings - solo ones are great or pairs
- brooches or pins
- Watches - faces and band
- Tie clasps
- Cufflinks
- Dog tags
- Crystals, gems, etc
- Barrettes, old hair pins
- You could bring seashells if you think they would go with your style
- Anything else you think you might like to include
- **Highly recommend bring if you have it**
  - Wire Cutter if you have it - there will be a few on hand
  - Fabric Scissors
  - Thin cardboard (like cereal box material size at least size 8x10 or larger to trim down)
  - tweezers
