### Tools needed to make pottery:

- Soft silicone pottery rib (included in basic tool set)
- Needle tool (included in basic tool set)
- Serrated rib or feather wire tool (included in basic tool set)
- Small round pottery sponge (included in basic tool set)
- Wire clay cutter (included in basic tool set)
- Hand towel you don't mind getting dirty

#### Additional tools for surface decoration (optional)

- Paint brush such as Aqualon Natural fan brush for glaze application
- Small blade such as an Xacto knife
- Underglaze transfer sheet such as Sanbao or Elan Transfers brand in any design. These are a one time use product.
- Mayco Designer Silkscreen of your choosing (I have bird silkscreens that you may use during class). These are reusable and last a long time.
- Silkscreen medium (optional). I will supply medium for the class project, but you will need to supply your own outside of the demo class period.

#### NOTE:

You may purchase a basic handbuilding tool kit from me on the first day of class. The basic kit is \$15 payable to me via cash or Venmo.

If you want to participate in surface decorating, please bring your own tools and materials to class. The materials and tools listed above are available on <a href="mailto:amazon.com">amazon.com</a> or at pottery supply stores such as clay-king.com, theceramicshop.com, or at Davens Ceramic Center. Davens is located at 5076 Peachtree Rd. Atlanta, Ga 30341. It is a good idea to call them first to inquire about the product you are interested in purchasing to see if it is in stock.
