Please bring the following basic tools to class every day:

- Needle Tool (included in basic tool set)
- Wire Cutter (included in basic tool set)
- Round Sponge (included in basic tool set)
- Scoring Tool (included in basic tool set)
- Soft Rubber Rib (included in basic tool set)
- Rubber band
- Hand towel you don't mind getting dirty

The following tools are optional, but you may want to bring your own to experiment with.

#### Surface Decorating Tools

- Paint brush such as Aqualon Natural fan brush for glaze application
- Small knife for carving
- Sgraffito tools
- Underglaze transfer sheet (such as Sanbao or Elan Transfers brand) in any design. These are a one time use product.
- Mayco Designer Silkscreen (any design you choose). Note: I have bird silkscreens that you may use during class. These are reusable and last a long time.
- Silkscreen medium to be used with Designer Silkscreens. I will supply medium for the class demo project. You will need to supply your own outside of the demo class period.
