My classes are designed to have you loosen up and experiment with a free-flow type of approach to watercolor. I do a demo at the beginning of each class. Come with an open mind and try on the instructions as demonstrated. Some of my students have achieved extraordinary results after working with me and went on to win awards for their art work. To make the most of what I have to offer I recommend you to come to class with a beginner's mind (even when studying at an advanced level), and trust the process.

Recommended

- Watercolor Paper: (140 lb. or 300 lb. cold press) 22"x30" paper sheet, or a large paper pad
- Watercolor Paints: Get the best paint you can afford. Artist grade paints are recommended. You may mix most colors from these basics:
 - from Daniel Smith: Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Lemon Yellow, Burnt Sienna
 - from Holbein: Opera (pink), Peacock Blue
 - A great quality yet inexpensive set to order from Amazon if you are on a low budget is: "24 SONNET STUDIO WATERCOLOURS Paint Set Russian". Note that this set does **not** come with a palette or a hard case.
- Watercolor Palette (one with a lid is recommended)
- Watercolor Brushes
 - Round Brushes (#2, #6, #12 smooth hair)
 - Flat Brush (1/2", 1" flat brush)
- Water Container (a large plastic container)
- Paper Towels (Viva are the best)
- Drawing Pencil #2
- Eraser
- Masking Tape or Painter's tape
- Sponge (any type)
- Small spray bottle
- A board to hold your paper
- Mr. Clean magic eraser sponge (optional)
- Masking liquid (optional)

- White gel pen (optional)
