- 140 lb. 100% cotton Watercolor paper sheets (at least 6) in sheets, tablets or blocks. Fabriano or Arches 8 x 10 and 11 x 14. Good paper results in good paintings
- Scrap watercolor paper to practice on, the back of old paintings you don't like are good for this.
- Your palette of professional watercolor from tubes. Be sure your palettes pads are full with paint, not just a dot or 2.
- Watercolor brushes. Variable sizes from a rigger to larger, ½ to 1 inch rounds and a flat brush or two
- A roll of paper towels, any kind. I like original Viva. A large water container, there are some in the classroom.
- **IMPORTANT:** We will use black waterproof pens and markers. One or two Sharpie Ultrafine Permanent Markers work. If you have a fountain pen that uses waterproof black ink, that is the best. Also, if you like, a very inexpensive set from Amazon is "Steadler 4 pigment Liner" and you get two extra pens!!
- Sketching pencils and for sure a KNEADED eraser is needed. I'll provide sketch paper for practice and some templates to copy for your paintings. This is not a drawing class. We will use light boxes to get quick sketches and outlines for our creations, and have a lot of time to paint rather than draw.
- Please bring a sack lunch and a beverage for yourself. We will have 30 minute break.

NOTE: Please arrive 15 minutes before class so we can start on time.
